

Notice Regarding the Release of Photographs for J. L. S. Web Pages

Students are frequently photographed when participating in classroom activities, athletics, and other special events. Such photographs often appear in PAUSD publications, and you have chosen whether to allow such photographs to be published on the PAUSD photograph form.

According to the PAUSD guidelines, student photographs may appear on the school web sites, with first names or initials only, with parent permission. This allows photos of student work and activities to be published on J.L.S.'s web pages.

Publication of student photographs on the World Wide Web has a larger audience than other District publications. The Internet is a global network created to support the open exchange of information among many different kinds of institutions all over the world. This means that the pages on the JLS site are accessible from outside the JLS community.

For this reason you have a separate option to **DENY permission** to publish student photographs on the J.L.S. web pages. Please fill out and return if your student's photograph **MAY NOT** appear on J.L.S.'s web pages.

PAUSD Guidelines for Developing World Wide Web Pages

From the Middle & High School Internet Contract

All web pages that PAUSD sponsors or permits to reside on its web servers shall reflect the character and mission of the District, school or school group creating or maintaining the web page. Pages shall have a clear purpose and contain meaningful information.

All web pages that become a part of the PAUSD web site must be created in the context of a course and under the supervision of an instructor.

Student work and images will be identified by first name or initials only.
